Key Vocabulary:

Pattern	an arrangement of lines or shapes.
Plaiting	the interlacing of strands.
Stitch	the process of making, mending or joining two pieces of material.
Techniques	the manner and ability with which an artist employs the technical skills of a particular art.
Weave	a method of textile production in which two distinct sets of yarns or threads are interlaced at right angles to form a fabric or cloth.
