#### Key Vocabulary:

country	A nation with its own government occupying a particular territory.
map	A visual representation of an entire area or part of an area.
physical feature	Anything that is on the Earth naturally.
human feature	Features that have been built by people.
rainfall	A measurement of how much water falls in a certain period.
hurricane	Strong storms that start in the ocean.
tropical	Warm or hot weather throughout the year.
season	A cycle of weather changes that happen throughout the year.
weather	This is a description of the conditions in a particular place: hot or cold, wet or dry and windy or calm.
England	The largest country in the UK.
Kenya	The country located in East Africa.
