attraction	A place that is popular with visitors.
beach	A strip of land that lies along the edge of an ocean, lake or river.
cliff	A rock that rises vertically.
coast	The area where land and sea meet.
harbour	A place on the coast where water meets land which is sheltered by natural or man-made walls.
port	A place where boats can come to and go from and where they can load and unload supplies and people.
sea	A body of saltwater.
season	A cycle of weather changes that happen throughout the year.
town	A place where people live and work that is larger than a village but smaller than a city.
weather	This is a description of the conditions in particular place: hot or cold, wet or dry and windy or calm.
