Friend	A friend is someone we like and who likes us back.
Kindness	Kindness is being nice and helpful to other people.
Honesty	honesty means telling the truth and being fair.
Argument	An argument is when two or more people disagree and talk loudly.
Resolve	To resolve means to make a decision about something, or to fix a problem.
Lonely	Lonely means feeling sad because you are alone, and you want to be with others.
Unhappy	Unhappy means not feeling well or not being cheerful.
Similarities	Similarities are the things that are alike or the same between two or more things.
Differences	Differences are the things that make two or more things not the same.
Cooperation	Cooperation means working together to achieve a common goal.
Share	To share means to let someone else use or have some of what you have.
Discussion	A discussion is when people talk about something to share their ideas.
Views	Views are opinions or thoughts about something.
