



Key Vocabulary:	
Brave	Brave means being able to do something even when you are scared.
Confident	Confident means feeling sure of yourself and what you can do.
Afraid	Afraid means feeling scared or worried about something.
Trusted	Trusted means being someone who can be relied on and has earned people's confidence.
Bullying	Bullying is when someone repeatedly hurts or teases another person on purpose.
Bystander	A bystander is someone who is watching a situation happen but is not involved.
Upstander	An upstander is someone who helps to stop bullying or stands up for someone being treated badly.
Melanin	Melanin is a substance in our skin, hair, and eyes that gives them their colour.
Unique	Unique means being one of a kind or different from everyone else.
Race	Race refers to a group of people who share similar physical features, like skin colour.
Racism	Racism is when someone treats people unfairly because of their race or ethnicity.
Equality	Equality means treating everyone the same and giving everyone the same opportunities.
