



**Key Vocabulary:**

Bullying	Bullying is when someone keeps being mean or hurtful to another person, often on purpose.
Consequence	A consequence is something that happens as a result of an action. It can be good or bad.
Hurtful behaviour	Hurtful behaviour is when someone does or says something that makes another person feel sad or upset.
Respectful behaviour	Respectful behaviour is when you treat others kindly and value their feelings and opinions.
Situation	A situation is a way of describing the circumstances or events that are happening at a certain time.
Respect	Respect is when you think well of someone and treat them well, by listening to them and being kind.
Self-respect	Self-respect is recognising your own worth and treating yourself well.
Polite	Polite means being kind and showing good manners to others.
Courtesy	Courtesy is showing polite behaviour and consideration towards others.
