Common interest	A common interest is something that people in a group enjoy or care about together.
Responsibility	Responsibility means being trusted to take care of something or someone.
Compassion	Compassion means caring about others and wanting to help them when they are sad or in trouble.
Digital	Digital refers to anything related to technology that uses numbers and electronics.
Technology	Technology is the use of machines, tools, and methods to solve problems and make life easier.
Branding	Branding is the way a company or product is recognised by its name, logo, or design.
Audience	An audience is a group of people who watch or listen to a performance or presentation.
Production	Production means making or creating something, usually in a large number.
Stereotypes	Stereotypes are oversimplified ideas or images of a group of people that may not be true.
