



Key Vocabulary:	
discrimination	Treating people differently to others.
prejudice	An unfair judgement of someone because of race, religion or sex.
diversity	Recognising people are different based on their backgrounds, interests and beliefs.
racism	Treating someone unfairly or harmfully (mentally or physically) based on their race, skin colour or where they come from.
anti-racism	Actively opposing racism.
stereotypes	A judgement (that is usually incorrect) based on how people look and act.
bystander	Someone who sees something happening but they do not actively get involved.
upstander	Someone who chooses to support a person who is being abused or harmed (mentally or physically)
